Item 2: Approval of January Meeting Summary

January meeting minutes were approved as presented at 3:03 p.m.

Item 3: Project Management Updates

The primary outcomes of the January meetings of the Gondola Subcommittee, Leadership Committee and Station Planning Workshops for the Town of Telluride and Mountain Village were recapped. Discussion included the 2025 Inter-Governmental Agreement for the planning process, project development budgeting, confirmation of Leadership Committee decision-making structure. The jurisdiction-specific Station Planning Workshops kicked off the localized planning process for the gondola stations in the Town of Telluride and Mountain Village that will be led by the respective local governments.



- Item 4: Gondola Transit Functions and Terminal/Station Planning Goals for the transit specific functions of the gondola station terminals were presented along with the basis of the design elements. The elements were categorized as standard and system-wide for essential transit functions or for local design, which would be addressed by the jurisdiction-specific planning process. Gondola station elements that overlapped were categorized as part of the essential transit functions so that they may be potentially eligible for future grant funding.
