San Miguel Authority for Regional Transportation Board of Directors Meeting April 10th, 2025 Regular Meeting Virtual meeting minutes

Member Directors Present: Town of Telluride – J. Meehan Fee, Ashley Story Von Spreecken. Town of Mountain Village – Harvey Mogenson, Tucker Magid.

Staff Present: David Averill, Amber Blake Kari Distefano, (SMART). Paul Taddune (legal counsel), Dalton Kelly (legal counsel) Others: Jim Loebe (Town of Mountain Village), Anton Benitez (TMVOA)

The meeting was called to order at 3:05 p.m.

Item 1: Public Comment

No public comment was offered.

Item 2: Resolution 2025-9, Part 1a, regarding the Review and Approval of the April 10th, 2025 Agenda and Consent Items and Part 1b, regarding the Review and Approval of March 13th, 2025 Meeting Minutes.

A unanimous vote approved the motion.

Item 3: SMART Pass products discussion

Distefano provided information about potential pass options that could be made available for online purchase through the new Token Transit app. She highlighted the possibility of offering annual or biannual passes. Ashley Von Spreecken expressed concern that these options might be financially burdensome for some riders and suggested that businesses could consider offering annual or biannual passes as an employee benefit.

Tucker Magid and Harvey Mogenson recommended that SMART offer discounted monthly passes rather than focusing on annual or biannual options. The Board agreed and decided that monthly passes should be offered at a 20% discount.

Distefano then asked the Board whether they wished to provide an additional discount for seniors and students. The Board agreed and approved a 25% discount for those passenger groups.

Item 4: March 2025 Operations Report

Distefano gave a report on March ridership and performance.

Item 5: Executive Directors Report

Averill updated the Board on preliminary formula funding from the Clean Transit Enterprise, a discussion with Rep. Hurd's office, and vehicle replacement strategy.

Item 6: Executive Session at 4:02 p.m. the Board entered an Executive Session pursuant to C.R.S. §24-6-402(4)(f), for a discussion on Executive Director work plan(s) and supporting personnel. The Board exited the Executive Session taking no action at 4:50 p.m.

Item 7: Executive Session at 4:51 p.m. the Board entered an Executive Session pursuant to C.R.S. §24-6-402(4)(b) for the purpose of conferring with legal counsel in the matter of Masson vs. San Miguel County BOCC, et. all. The Board exited the Executive Session taking no action at 5:09 p.m.

RECITALS:

WHEREAS, the San Miguel Authority for Regional Transportation ("SMART") was approved by the registered electors of the Town of Telluride, Town of Mountain Village, Town of Rico and that portion of the SMART combination that are within that part of the SMART boundaries located within unincorporated San Miguel County, pursuant to the Colorado Regional Transportation Authority Law, C.R.S. Title 43, Article 4, Part 6; and

WHEREAS, SMART is governed by the Colorado Regional Transportation Authority Law and SMART Intergovernmental Agreement ("SMART IGA") conditionally approved by each of the governing bodies of the Town of Telluride, Town of Mountain Village, San Miguel County and the Town of Rico, and with the approval of the registered electors of those jurisdictions; and

WHEREAS, the Board held a regular meeting on May 8thth, 2025; and

WHEREAS, Section 3.09 of the SMART IGA requires all actions of the Board to be taken by written resolution; and

WHEREAS, the Board desires to take action on certain items set forth below in accordance with the SMART IGA.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE SAN MIGUEL AUTHORITY FOR REGIONAL TRANSPORTATION AS FOLLOWS:

A RESOLUTION OF THE SAN MIGUEL AUTHORITY FOR REGIONAL TRANSPORTATION SUPPORTING A YES VOTE ON THE EXCISE TAX QUESTION REFERRED BY THE TOWN OF MOUNTAIN VILLAGE SEEKING VOTER APPROVAL FOR A 5% EXCISE TAX ON LIFT TICKET SALES FOR THE PURPOSE OF FUNDING REGIONAL TRANSPORTATION

RESOLUTION 2025-11

WHEREAS, in accordance with the Taxpayer's Bill of Rights, Article X, Section 20 of the Colorado Constitution ("TABOR"), governmental entities are required to seek advance voter approval for any new tax or tax increase it seeks to impose; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of Mountain Village has placed a question on the ballot for the June 24th, 2025 municipal election, seeking voter approval to impose an excise tax rate of 5% on certain lift ticket products for the purpose of funding gondola operations, maintenance and capital replacement funds ; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with the Colorado Fair Campaign Practices Act (C.R.S. § 1- 45-117) the Smart Board of Directors may pass a resolution taking a position on any ballot issue; and

WHEREAS, local Elected Officials and staff have engaged with residents to hear about the community's priorities regarding the need to find a funding source for the Gondola rebuild project; and

WHEREAS, residents and business leaders from throughout the region have spoken about the importance of ensuring a viable future of the gondola as it is recognized as a critical piece of transportation infrastructure in the region; and

WHEREAS, a survey of residents showed that significant ski area financial participation in the gondola rebuild project is one of the top priorities of the regions residents; and

WHEREAS, SMART worked in good faith for six months with Telluride Ski and Golf to come to a formal agreement to ensure meaningful ski area contributions to the gondola project; and

WHEREAS, SMART and Telluride Ski and Golf could not come to such an agreement; and

WHEREAS, SMART and its local government partners were explicitly clear that if a funding agreement failed to materialize between SMART and Telluride Ski and Golf that such a ballot question would be placed on the June 24th 2025 Town of Mountain Village ballot for voter approval;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE SAN MIGUEL AUTHORITY FOR REGIONAL TRANSPORTATION THAT THE SMART BOARD OF DIRECTORS HEREBY SUPPORTS A "YES" VOTE ON THE TOWN OF MOUNTAIN VILLAGE EXCISE TAX BALLOT QUESTION AND URGES THE REGISTERED ELECTORS OF MOUNTAIN VILLAGE TO VOTE IN FAVOR OF THE PROPOSED 5% EXCISE TAX FOR VITAL REGIONAL TRANSPORTATION SERVICES FOR OPERATIONS, MAINTENANCE AND CAPITAL FUNDING OF THE GONDOLA.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION/KEY POINTS: Highlights and comparisons for Q1 from 2023 through Q1 2025:

Ridership and Cost Effectiveness:

Note: Montrose service was added on February 17th, 2025. Rico weekend service was added in mid-November 2024.

The Nucla/Naturita Route, which includes the 7:25 AM departure in the morning from Norwood and the 5:00 PM departure from Telluride in the afternoon has had the lowest cost per passenger trip all three years (\$10.64, \$7.91, \$7.88).

The Lawson Hill/Mountain Village Route has had the highest cost per passenger trip in 2023 (\$46.64), but the Down Valley Route (\$30.09) had the highest cost per passenger trip in 2024 and the Montrose Route has had the highest cost per passenger trip in 2025 (\$30.57). Bear in mind that the Montrose Route did not start until February 17th of this year. I expect the cost per passenger trip for the Montrose Route to come down in the second quarter.

The reported cost per passenger trip for the vanpools is a little misleading. The Mountain Village Shop does the Vanpool maintenance. The three vanpools that transport the Mountain Village Shop workers fuel at the Mountain Village shop. The Mountain Village's billing for the vanpool fuel and maintenance is erratic. We often go for months without seeing bills.

Fare collection went from \$25,380 in 2023 to \$23,574 in 2024 to \$20,530 in 2025. Fares from Rico and Down Valley were not collected in 2025. This accounts for the drop in that income.

Incidents, Complaints, Accidents and Performance:

The accident in Q1 of 2025 was a fender bender in the Lawson Hill Park & Ride. One of our 40' buses clipped a vehicle. Incidents included bad weather, a driver missing a shift on Down Valley and two Rico shifts being missed. There were complaints about over crowded Rico buses. There was a complaint about a vehicle not being able to pass a bus on the spur and a complaint about a driver being aggressive.

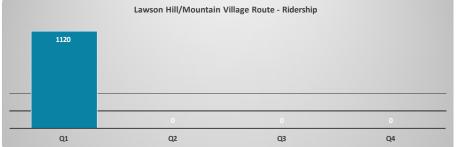












Lawson Hill/Mountain Village Route - Cost per Passenger Trip

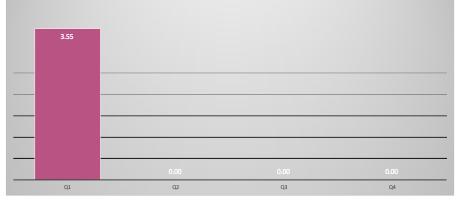

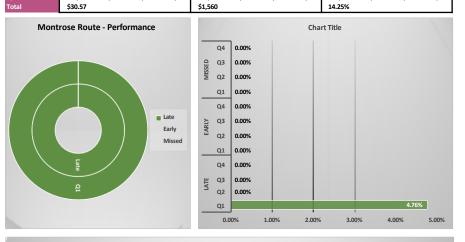

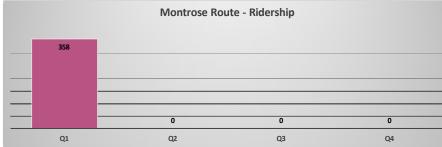

Montrose Route - Passenger per Revenue Hour





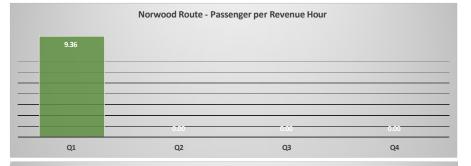




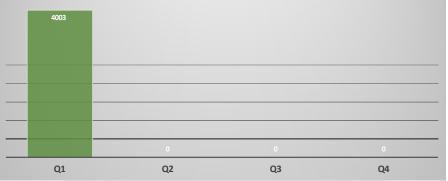
